

Our Financial Policy

Thank you for choosing us for your child's dental care. We would like to take a minute to let you know our office financial policy.

Non-insured patients are expected to pay in full the day services are rendered. We do accept cash, check, and credit cards. We also offer payment plans through [Care Credit Services](#).

For those patients who are covered by insurance we will accept assignment of benefits. This means you must sign the portion of your insurance that "assigns" payment to our office. Most dental insurance plans do not cover 100% of the cost of your treatment. Because of this and the extreme delay in receiving payment from the insurance company, you will be asked to pay your deductible and your portion of charges the day services are rendered. All estimates are based on information provided to us by your insurance and are not a guarantee of payment. Only after a claim is submitted and reviewed by your insurance company can final payment be determined. We are a non-preferred provider for all PPO insurance plans, except Delta Premier, and this may also affect your out of pocket cost. We will assist you in dealing with your insurance company the best we can.

We will estimate as closely as possible your coverage, but until we actually receive payment from your insurance company, IT IS JUST AN ESTIMATE. The ultimate responsibility lies with you. After forty-five days, any remaining balance not received from your insurance will be due in full from you. All unpaid balances over thirty days are subject to a finance charge. All unpaid balances over ninety days will be turned over to a collection agency.

A \$50 fee may be charge for a missed appointment without a 24-hour notice.
